4. The governing body shall consist of the following (this depends on the number and categories of schools in the federation under Part 4 of the federation regulations):

5. Total number of governors: 17, unless the Headteacher resigns the office of governor in accordance with regulation 19 of the Constitution Regulations 2012, in which case the total number of governors shall be 16.

6. The Lichfield Diocesan Board of Education is the foundation body entitled to appoint foundation governors.

7. a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:

The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parishes of Newborough and Rangemore.

b) The Archdeacon of Stoke upon Trent shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 23 (2) of the Regulations, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his governorship exists.

8. The Archdeacon of Stoke upon Trent shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor

9. Both schools have Church of England Status and as such have religious characters. The schools will serve their communities by providing children with an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian values, thereby preparing them for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of adult life. Our schools are happy and secure, where every child achieves their full potential; where everyone works, plays and co-operates with others in a Christian, caring way.

10. This instrument comes into effect on 1 April 2014.

11. This instrument was made by order of Staffordshire Local Authority on April 1st 2014.

12. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the Headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
