### Parking Guidelines / Code of Conduct PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICLE SAFETY

This code of conduct has been introduced to ensure the safety of all of us, especially the children. It should also help in the efforts of the school to be a good neighbour to the local community. Below are a series of points that should be observed by all people parking outside the school. If someone other than yourself collects your child/children, please make them aware of this code of conduct.

- Do not park or drop children off on the zig zag lines;
- Do not turn or park in front of resident's driveways;
- Do not park in front of gates leading into fields;
- Do not block the village carpark (All Saints);
- No vehicles to move within the school grounds between:  
8.40am and 9.15am  
(with mindful movement during the hours of Rangemore Rascals)  
3.00pm and 4.30pm  
(with mindful movement of staff whilst school clubs and afterschool provision are in session).  
unless in case of emergency;
- No parking outside or opposite the school gates
- Do not park close to or opposite a junction (within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, near the brow of a hill).
- Adhere to road markings.



#### Always

- Try walk from home if local OR to 'park and stride' even from the club/pub car park.
- Make sure your child gets out of the car on the pavement side
- Always look out for children/pedestrians when parking.
- Be patient and considerate when congestion does occur.

Additionally, localised arrangements are put in place and into risk assessments where children are disabled. Disabled staff and visitors park on the school carpark.

**Remember: 'Stay clear, children are near – think before you park!'**
