# All Saints PTA 50/50 Club



## Your chance to win a monthly cash prize! - 'You have to be in it to win it'

What is the 50/50 Club? - The 50/50 club is a monthly prize draw run by the PTA where 50% of cash generated makes up the monthly prizes and 50% goes to the PTA towards essential and fun resources for your children and the school.

What could I win? - 1<sup>st</sup> Prize = 40%, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize = 5%, 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize = 5%

The amount that you could win depends on how many draws are sold.

The more who enter the greater the monthly prize!
