FLU VACCINE NASAL SPRAY

WELLBEING— STAFFORDSHIRE WELLBEING CLINIC

Please see the attached leaflet from the school immunisation team regarding the nasal flu vaccine. . It also provides a link to the NHS website for further information and sign-posts parents to their GP, school nurse or health visitor if they wish to discuss the immunisation further. The team are scheduled to come into school on 16th December 2020—consent forms for this will be sent out as soon as received.





Please see attached for some information regarding The Wellbeing Clinic which may be useful for adults faces challenges with emotional wellbeing. They offer support to those suffering with low mood, anxiety stress or panic. They are a self-referral service who cover the Staffordshire area, in particular, Tamworth, Lichfield, Burntwood, Stafford, Cannock, Seisdon, Burton and Uttoxeter. They offer Cognitive Behavioural Therapy and Counselling.

Once an individual contacts they service on 0300 303 0923, they are asked to leave their name and number and they will be calledas soon as possible to proceed with their referral. Once they are registered onto the system, they aim to offer a telephone assessment appointment within 5 days to gain an understanding of the presenting problem before discussing the options available.

Half of the children took it in turns to use a knife to have a go at whittling and they all did extremely well. The others will do this next week – please make sure you bring your mask with you. 🛙


