We are so excited to share our special 'Grass Not Gravel' project with you whilst also managing your expectations and those of our very excited children.

For many years we have explored the idea of using a portion of the field next to the school so that it is more accessible for our children. It hasn't been feasible in the past but this year we spoke with Rangemore Estate in order to explore the possibility and they said YES!!

Since then things have moved swiftly and, after surveys and quotes for works, we are now in a position to apply for planning permission in order to hopefully change the use of this land from agricultural to recreational in order to use it for playtime, lunchtimes and lessons whilst also paying to use the playing field over the road for PE lessons.



In order to secure planning permission **WE NEED YOU** to help put a voice behind this project with as many positive responses to Staffordshire County Council as possible. **As soon as we have the link we will send it out to everyone.**




PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS

Christmas Wreaths & Candles – Tuesday 1st December


