

Uniform	White blouse/shirt or white polo shirt, Bottle green sweatshirt with school logo or Bottle green jumper or cardigan, Grey or black trousers / shorts / skirt / pinafore or green checked gingham dress for Summer, Skirt/dresses must be no shorter than 1 inch above the knee. White, grey or black socks, Plain tights may be worn - opaque tights are preferred (green / black / grey), Shoes should be low, black flat-heeled for safety and fasten securely. Shoes should always be full (no sandals). Velcro or magnetic fastenings are preferable to laces for younger children.
PE / games / swimming Kit All PE kits should be free from any brand logo or name	Indoor:  White T-shirt, Bottle green shorts, change of socks, Outdoor: white T-shirt/polo shirt, black shorts, trainers, Black Tracksuits may be worn at appropriate times. KS2 Swimming Swimming trunks or one-piece costume should be worn, Swimming caps will be worn by all children, Items should be in a named waterproof bag.
