## **USEFUL INFORMATION**

## PE KITS—SEPTEMBER 2021



PE lessons will start from next week (beginning Monday 6th September). The children will need to come into school in their PE kits on their PE days. The kits required is specified in our school uniform policy and in addition, we ask that children

wear a school jumper or cardigan on top. For the purposes of PE the children may need to bring their tracksuit top in too for warmth, depending on the weather. Please can we also ask that all children bring in their shorts on Monday 6th September (preferably green, but if they have black ones that is fine) and they can keep them in their classroom drawer for a half term. The children can then come into school in their tracksuit bottoms on PE days and change into their shorts if required.

PE Days will be as follows:

Class 1 - Monday and Wednesday Class 2 - Tuesday and Thursday Class 3 - Tuesday and Friday

Milkshakes 60p


Please can the correct change be brought in where possible if your child would like to purchase anything.

### LUNCH MENU

Our school lunch menu for next week (week 2) is attached to this Newsletter. Lunches are free for all Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. school lunches for Year 3 upwards are charged at £2.34 payable on Parent Pay. There is no need to pre-order, children just need to let their class teacher know their choice on the day during morning registration.

Our school colour is bottle green
<ul> <li>White blouse/shirt or white polo shirt,</li> <li>Bottle green sweatshirt with school logo or Bottle green jumper or cardigan,</li> <li>Grey or black trousers / shorts / skirt / pinafore or green checked gingham dress for Summer, <i>Skirt/dresses must be no shorter than 1 inch above the knee.</i></li> <li>White, grey or black socks,</li> <li>Plain tights may be worn - opaque tights are preferred (green / black / grey),</li> <li>Shoes should be low, black flat-heeled for safety and fasten securely. Shoes should always be full (no sandals). Velcro or magnetic fastenings are preferable to laces for younger children.</li> </ul>
Indoor: • White T-shirt.
<ul><li>Bottle green shorts,</li><li>change of socks,</li></ul>
Outdoor: • white T-shirt/polo shirt, • black shorts, • trainers, • Black Tracksuits may be worn at appropriate times. KS2 Swimming • Swimming trunks or one-piece costume should be worn, • Swimming caps will be worn by all children, • Items should be in a <b>named</b> waterproof bag.

#### WRAP AROUND CARE

If you would like your child to attend Breakfast or Afterschool Club please remember to complete the booking form and send to the School Office. It is important that all spaces are pre-booked to allow us to manage to clubs effectively. Further information is attached. If your child is new and you would like to register your child for Breakfast/Afterschool Club please email the office in order for a registration form to be sent out to you.

## **REPORTING ABSENCE**

If you child is poorly please remember to phone the school office from 8.30am to confirm their absence from school in the morning. If your child has any COVID-19 symptoms, no matter how mild, please do not send them into school and arrange a PCR test. If children develop these symptoms in school they will be isolated and sent home for a PCR test to be taken. The symptoms are:

a high temperature

a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours

a loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.
