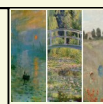

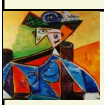

It would be interesting to find out who has found the oldest tree.

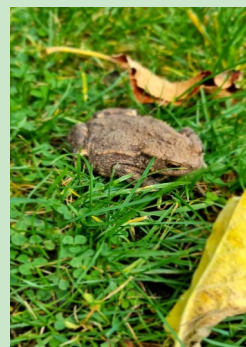
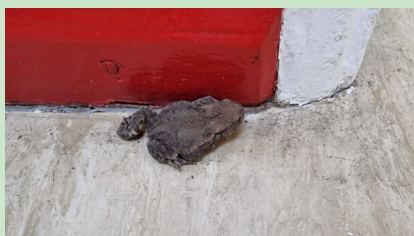
We continued with bow sawing - only a couple of children left to have a go next week.

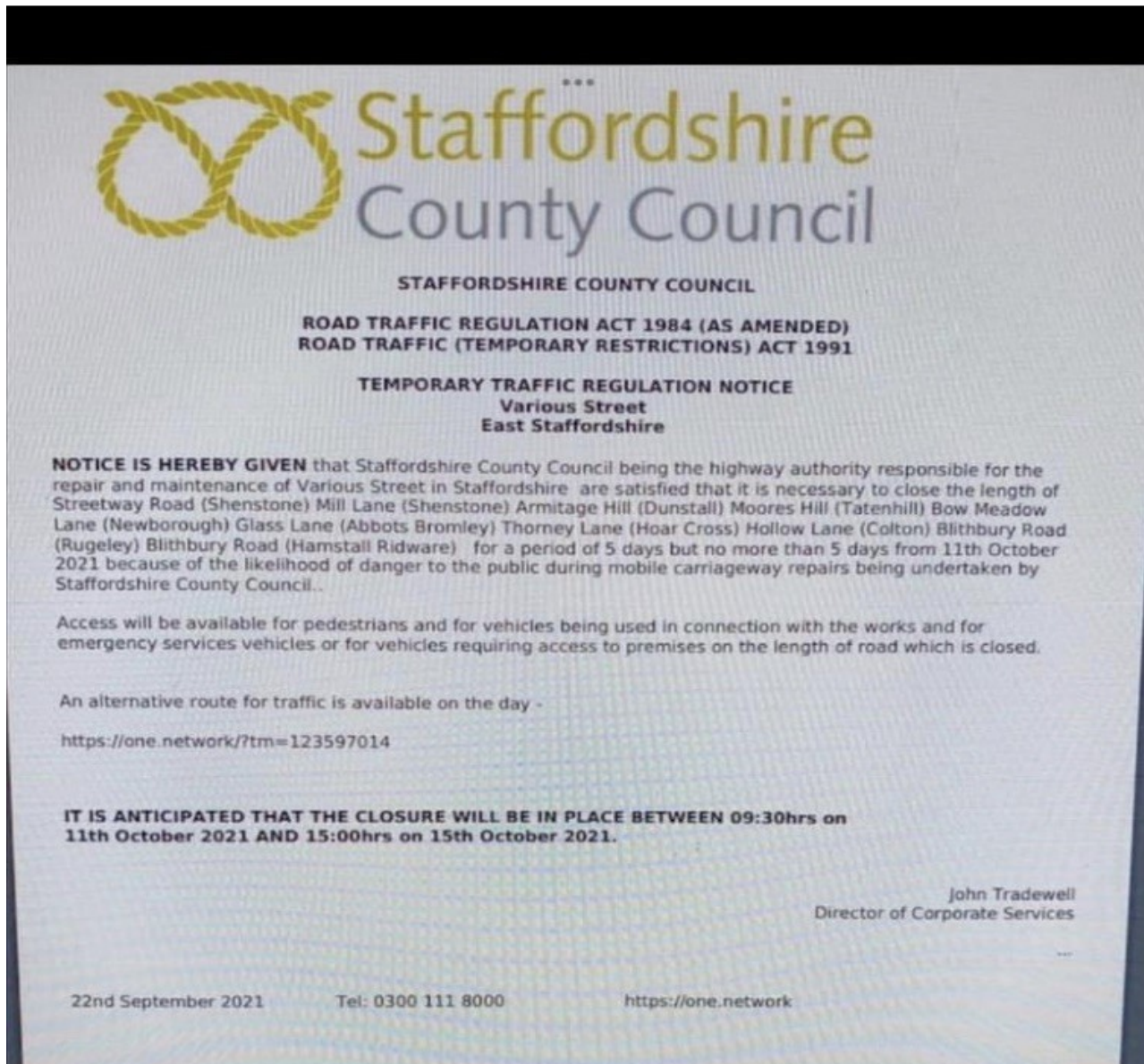
