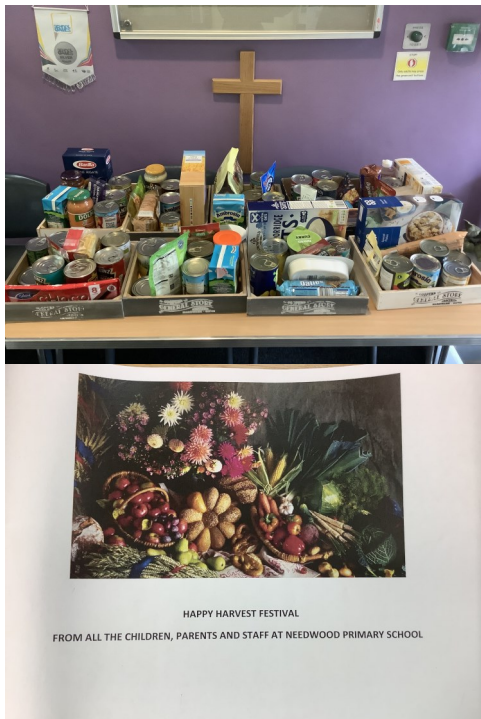
It has been great to see both schools take part in the Dove Valley Football Tournament last Friday the children really enjoyed . I hear they had some quite tricky teams to play.

The Children's Flu Immunisation team will be with us in school on Monday 18th October. Please check your emails from the School Office (emailed on the 30.09.21) to follow and submit your e-consent form. Please ensure that you complete and submit your child's consent form promptly, **whether you wish your child to be immunised or not and only submit one consent form per child.** This will need to be completed by **12:30pm on 15th October 2021.**

MOVIE NIGHT



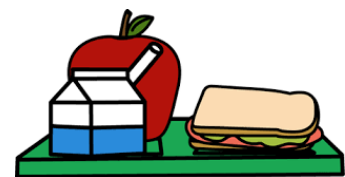
Afterschool club are delighted to announce that Movie Nights are back!
