

Squid Game features scenes that depict extreme violence and gore, strong language and frightening moments that are, according to its rating, simply not suitable for primary and early high school aged children. An aggressive version of a familiar children's game, red light, green light, is played in the series. This, and other inappropriate content are negatively influencing playground games and children at school have been caught playing these games on the playground. There are also 'cartoons' circling you tube of characters playing versions of the game. Please be vigilant on what your child is watching. We will be taking children playing these games on the playground seriously.

The Benefice of Hanbury, Newborough, Rangemore will hold its remembrance service on the 14th November at Rangemore. Service will begin at 10:45am so that the one-minute silence can start at 11:00 am.
