An aggressive version of a familiar children's game, red light, green light, is played in the series. This, and other inappropriate content are negatively influencing playground games and children at school have been caught playing these games on the playground. There are also 'cartoons' circling you tube of characters playing versions of the game. Please be vigilant on what your child is watching. We will be taking children playing these games on the playground seriously.
