Facebook challenge

It has come to our attention that there is "A Game" being circulated via Facebook to children which contains several different actions for them to complete, including the encouragement of self-harm and hurting others.

Whilst many of our children will, I am sure, be confident in ignoring these messages, we wanted to make you aware that this is circulating. Thank you for reminding children of the importance of speaking to adults at home whenever they come across something that feels unusual or unsafe.



What a blustery start to our Forest School session but as is the ethos of Forest School as long as we are wrapped up well the great outdoors is still a joy. We did need to leave about 5 minutes early as it became a little too windy which is quite unusual but luckily we were able to finish our drink, biscuit and end with a great sing-a-long.

As is always the case on the first week, some of the time was taken up getting all kitted out. Each child was allocated an all-in one which they will wear every week. A water proof coat, hat, gloves and wellies are still needed and once bundled up we were set for a fun afternoon.

Lots of wild play, tree climbing and rope swinging. The children also went on a treasure hunt and showed the group additionally we found some insects including a worm and wood lice to have a closer look at.

Everyone fully joined in when they had to guess the typical age of various birds that live in the garden. The common pigeon usually lives about 4 years but in captivity the oldest has lived to 44 years!
