

Our first session of Forest School was a little wet but that did not stop us from having a great time. In fact perfect weather for worm hunting. The children had a marvellous time and even the ones that 'don't like worms' had fun. They found LOTS of worms and learnt a lot too:

A worm does not have ears and use vibrations from the ground to "hear"
In an acre of land there can be a million worms
There are more than 3,000 different species of earthworm that exist in the world
Worms can have between one and five pairs of hearts
Sunlight can kill a worm because they are sensitive to UV light

Each child also used secateurs to snip up an old Christmas tree ready for fire lighting in a few weeks and also a pair of loppers to see the difference between the two tools and how using the right tool makes a job so much easier.

Of course they all enjoyed some wild play too and a lot of fun was have by all.
