#### SET PARENTAL CONTROLS

Roblox comes with several parental control options, which are explained well on the game's official website. It's essential to enter the correct date of birth for your child, as that allows Roblox to automatically apply the appropriate chat filters. The game also allows parents and carers to set monthly spending restrictions and monitor their child's account.

### DISABLE PRIVATE MESSAGING

#### **PRIVATE SERVERS**

If your child has some genuine friends to play Rob online with, paying for a private or VIP server decr the risk of contact from strangers. Even then, how some players could invite other people – who mig necessarily be child friendly – into the private ser-your child is a Roblox fan, it's important to talk with regularly about who they are playing the game with

#### MONITOR SPENDING

If they don't understand they're using real money, it's easy for children to accidentally spend a sizeable amount in the game. 
