The peg blade has triangular teeth usually set in threes with a gap in the middle and a raker blade which has regular teeth. The peg blade is usually used on dry, seasoned wood and the raker on green wood.

All the children could tell the difference when sawing their wood cookie and virtually all preferred the peg as the post we were sawing was very dry.
