After last week's bitterly cold day it was a lovely to have a much milder day. After a 'wild play' session we talked about trees. The children learnt about trees and how to work out their ages. They divided into two teams and were given a measuring tape. They had to measure 4 different trees of their choosing around their circumference and then guess their ages. We then came back to the fire circle, and I explained how to work this out.

Because a tree, on average, grows in girth (circumference) approximately 2.5 cm per year, by dividing the children's measurements of the trees by 2.5 we could work out their age. For example, a tree with a girth of 40 cm will be approximately sixteen years old. There are some differences between trees i.e. Oak and Beech 1.88 cm per year, Pine and Spruce 3.13 cm per year and Sycamore 2.75 per year so on this occasion we divided by 2.75 . The results between the teams were incredibly close. In fact they drew on their original task and when I chose another tree for them to guess the age the difference between the teams was $0.4!!!$

Great job everyone.
Another task, in between tree climbing and tyre swinging was to put up the remaining posters made by Class 4 to encourage the public to take their rubbish home with them. Any child that hasn't had their poster put up yet please don't worry we will regularly change them.

Lastly, can I say the last week of Forest School, week beginning $5^{\text {th }}$ February, the day when it will be held will be changed from Thursday $8^{\text {th }}$ to Tuesday $6^{\text {th }}$ February due to a conflicting diary date.
